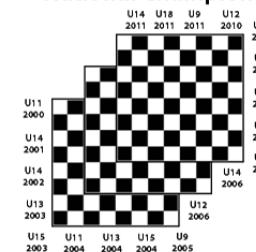

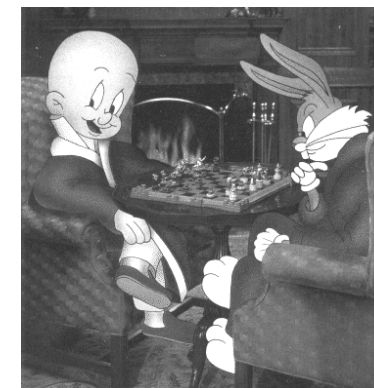

Eligibility

Open to anyone aged under 18 at midnight on August 31st 2011 and who is either resident in, or attends school in Sussex.

I'm a beginner, is this for me?

Definitely yes. If you like playing chess, then you'll love playing better. Our training sessions are for boys and girls of any level - and we emphasise enjoyment, not just 'classroom' learning.

Half day training (2½ hours) is especially suitable for beginners and younger children whose concentration spans may be limited.

Just mention on your entry form that you are a beginner and we will make sure that you receive the most suitable trainer.

Do I have to go to all training sessions?

No, but most juniors just love coming to see their friends and working their way towards a place in one of the county teams. If you are coming to lots of events, then you should become an SJC member and save money on entry fees.

Do I need to be a member?

No – but if you decide to attend regularly becoming a member entitles you to discounted entry fees and other benefits.

More loosely organised with games and quizzes. Established favourites are consultation team matches (here 5 juniors and their trainer take on a similar group in a different room!) and simultaneous matches (where some 30 juniors take on a top trainer).

Who are the trainers?

We have several professional chess coaches, and also club players who have been specially selected for their ability to work with young people. All hold enhanced CRB clearance for working with children.

Due to the extra work involved with late entries, a reduction of £3.00 per junior is given for entries postmarked at least seven days prior to the event.

SJC Membership discount

If you have SJC family membership, then you can also deduct **£1.00** for each child being entered.

SJC Family Membership

At £9.00 per family per year this is great value.

Membership entitles you to an entry fee reduction of £1.00 per child for most Grand Prix and training events in the year.
