



## Eligibility:

To qualify as a Sussex player, children must be normally resident in Sussex, or attend a school or chess club in Sussex, or have previously represented Sussex in a chess tournament.

## Sussex Under 7 Closed

Open to those aged under 7 at midnight on August 31<sup>st</sup> 2011 and who qualify as a Sussex player.

## Sussex Under 7 School Teams

Schools with three or more players who complete all rounds will be eligible for the school team prizes.

In the event of a tie in any of the placings, the score of a school's fourth best player will be used as a tie break.

## Free coaching

We are holding one of our coaching and fun days alongside the under 7 championships. Your child may join in with the afternoon activities (no charge) after the U7 tournament is finished if they wish - just tick the box on the entry form so we can ensure we have enough trainers.

## Rate of play

Each round lasts for 30 minutes. Games unfinished at the end of 30 minutes will be adjudicated.

This is not a knockout tournament – every child plays in every round.

Clocks will not be used.

Parents are allowed into the playing area but they must not interfere or comment on games, nor may they advise or coach a child whilst a match is in progress.

## Prizes

- Trophies will be awarded to the top three players. The winner will receive the trophy and title of Sussex U7 Champion.
- A trophy will be awarded to the top girl.
- Trophies and medals for the three highest placed school teams (best 3 scores count)
- No player may win more than one trophy.
