Although this Congress is organised by Wiltshire Junior Chess it is open to any player under 18 on (and all ages are 'as at') 31st August 2011.

- Players living in, at school in, born in, or with a County of First Allegiance of Cornwall, Devon, Somerset, Dorset, Gloucestershire, Hampshire, or Wiltshire, are eligible to win the West of England Championship titles.
- Players living in, at school in, born in, or with a County of First Allegiance of Wiltshire, are eligible to win the Wiltshire Championship titles.

The decision of the Chief Controller is final in all chess matters. The decision of the Organisers is final in all other matters, including the right to refuse entry or amalgamate or change the format of any section with a low entry.

Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children at all times, and in all places, during the Congress. All donations are gratefully received and will be used to promote junior chess in Wiltshire

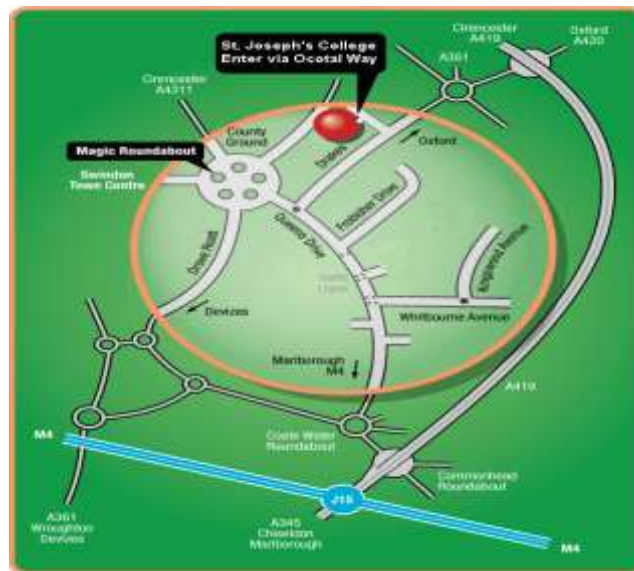

Prize Fund : £320 plus Championship trophies.

Five round Swiss. 30 moves in 75 mins, clocks set back 15 mins, all further moves in time remaining.
Play may continue until 7:30 pm on Saturday.

Minor (Sat/Sun)

Eligibility: Any U18 with an ECF grade of under 140.
Incorporating: Wiltshire Minor Junior Championship.
Prize Fund : £125 plus Championship trophy(s).
1st : £70, 2nd : £35 are guaranteed.
Six round Swiss. 65 minutes each, play to finish.

U12 Championship (Sat/Sun)

ECF Junior, John Robinson & Ian Cowen Memorial Prix and also an EPSCA U11 England Trial qualifying event.
Incorporating: West of England U12 & Girls U12 & Wiltshire U12 & U11 & Girls U12 Championships.
Prize Fund : £270 plus Championship trophies.
1st : £120, 2nd : £60, 3rd : £30 are guaranteed.
Six round Swiss, 65 minutes each, play to finish.

Under 12 Challengers (Sat/Sun)

Eligibility: U12 & ECF Grade of U100 or ungraded.
Prize Fund : £120 plus trophies.
1st : £60, 2nd : £30 are guaranteed.
Six round Swiss, 65 minutes each, play to finish.

Under 10 (Sat/Sun)

ECF Junior Prix & John Robinson Grand Prix
Incorporating: West of England U10 & Girls U10 and Wiltshire Under 10 Championships.
Prize Fund: £135 plus Championship trophies.
1st : £60, 2nd : £30 are guaranteed.
Min. 6 round Swiss, 65 mins each, play to finish.

Under 9 (Sat/Sun)

Incorporating: West of England Under 9 and Wiltshire Under 9 Championships.
